Meyers wins GNT - Open

The team captained by Jill Meyers rallied from 27 IMPs down in the fourth quarter to win the first Grand National Teams Championship Flight, 138-132, over the squad led by Rose Meltzer.

Meyers, of Santa Monica CA, was playing with Ed Davis, Seal Beach CA; Mitch Dunitz, Sherman Oaks CA, and Iftikhar Baqai, Irvine CA. They represented District 23.

Their opponents, representing District 21, were Meltzer, Peter Weichsel, Los Gatos CA; Hugh Ross, Oakland CA; Chip Martel, Davis CA; Kyle

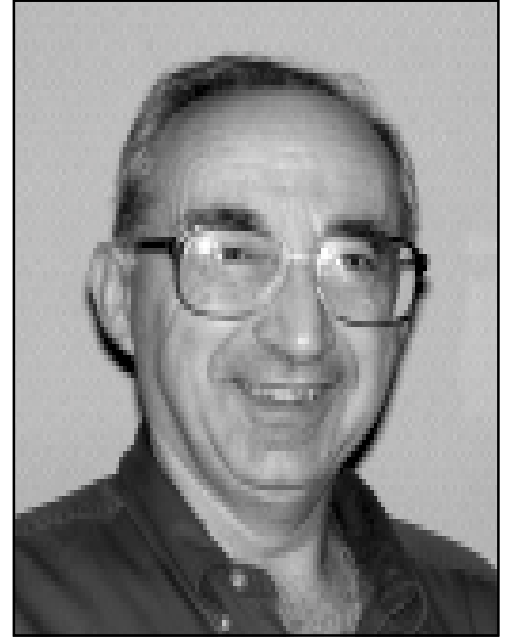

Retek elected ACBL President for 2002

George Retek, who has represented District 1 on the ACBL Board of Directors for 22 years, has been elected President for 2002. The election occurred during meetings of the Board prior to the start of the Toronto NABC.

In addition to his service on the ACBL Board, Retek is vice president and treasurer of the World Bridge Federation and is liaison for the 2002 World Bridge Championships in Montreal.

Greco-Passell lead Life Master Pairs

Eric Greco and Mike Passell had two good sessions in the semifinals of the Life Master Pairs to surge into the lead as the qualifiers head into today's two-session final. They compiled a score of 2601.32, to give them a small lead over three pairs that are closely bunched.

In second place with 2543.59 are Philip Becker and Kumar Bhatia. That gave them an infinitesimal 1.01-point edge over Michael Schuster and Varis Carey. But the margin between third and fourth was even smaller - .40 points. Mildred Breed and Shawn Quinn are fourth.

South plays 3NT after opening a strong 1NT. West leads the ♠3. Here is what Bobby Wolff in the Aces on Bridge syndicated column had to say about the deal.

Every beginner is familiar with the maxim "third hand high." It is one of the earliest teachings he commits to memory. What about exceptions to the rule? These are not usually covered in the classroom; one must rely on individual on-the-spot analysis. Usually, a bit of simple arithmetic will point the way.

East begins his analysis before he sees West's opening lead. He has heard South's opening of 1NT and North's raise to game. What does a look at his own 14 high-card points tell him? With only a 40-point deck, it tells him that West must have a near yarborough.

When West leads a fourth-best spade, East's preliminary analysis prepares him for an alert play. Instead of playing a routine third-hand high, East inserts his jack (a long study might give the show away).

Fearing the king is with West's long suit, South will surely take his queen. When South knocks out East's ♥A, East springs a surprise by returning the ♠K to dummy's ace. South's last chance lies with a successful club finesse, and when it fails East defeats the game, leading his ♠7 to West's 10.

Note that the routine play of the ♠K at trick one gives South an easy game. With West's spades neutralized, South can safely win three club tricks and two tricks in each of the other suits.

Junior Corps adds three members

Three young players were added to the ACBL Junior Corps Saturday at a reception honoring the organization's Junior players.

New Junior Corps members are Paul Bethe of Jersey City NJ, Jason Feldman of Champaign IL and John Kranyak of Bay Village OH. They were presented by Aileen Osofsky, chairman of the ceremonies honoring the Juniors.

The Junior Corps was established by Bobby Wolff in 1991 to honor Junior players who promote the game of bridge and present a proper image for bridge.

Also at the Junior reception:

- Alex Phillips of Little Rock AR was announced as the winner of the Homer Shoop Pre-Teen Scholarship for \$5000.

- Shawn Quinn announced that on Junior Day at the 2002 Spring NABC in Houston, there will be a regional pair event for Juniors. The winning players will each receive a \$5000 scholarship.

- Jade Barrett made his annual donation to the Junior Fund, presenting a check to Charlotte Blaiss, who coordinates Junior programs for the ACBL.

- Blaiss announced that there will be a Junior bridge camp July 29 to Aug. 5 in 2002, right after the Summer NABC in Washington DC.

- Jonathan Steinberg, who represents District 2 on the ACBL Board of Directors, announced that the ACBL Educational Foundation will subsidize each North American Junior participating in the Junior Bridge Camp. The \$200 subsidy will make the cost of the camp about \$225 per Junior.

- College teams were introduced and college Juniors will encouraged to enter the event in 2002. The finalists will win a trip to the 2002 Summer NABC in Washington DC. Dates for the qualifying event will be announced in September.

A further note on Junior matters: Canada's Erin Anderson is the 2001 ACBL Queen of Bridge.

College team title goes to San Diego

Four University of California at San Diego students who are working toward Ph.D.'s put their heads together to win the College Championship Teams yesterday. Down by 2 IMPs at the half, they came back strong and won by 12.

Originally there were teams from nine colleges, with six qualifying to come to Toronto.

Cameron Parker of Phoenix (math) and Sriram Ramabhadran of India (computer science) have been playing together for only three months. They started their partnership with this event in mind. They keep it simple, playing Standard American with only a few frills.

The other partnership consisted of Graham Hazel of Cambridge, England (math) and Eugene Hung of San Diego (computer science). Their methods are even simpler than their teammates' – four-card majors and natural bidding.

Playing for MIT were Jonathon Weinstein, Brian Lee and Andrew Thomas of Cambridge MA and Jason Woolever of Sunnyvale CA.

Both Hazel and Hung have outstanding records in Junior bridge. Hazel has played in four European Junior Championships – he won a bronze medal at one of them. Hung was a member of the United States Junior Team at the World Championships in Maastricht, the Netherlands, last year.

In the semifinals, San Diego defeated Carnegie-Mellon and MIT topped Stanford.

Go low, score high

On this deal from the first qualifying session of the Life Master Pairs, what appeared to be an error by David Berkowitz turned into a 14-point play. Their opponents, who reported the deal, were Colin Harrington of Cambridge ON and John Moser of St. Agatha ON.

Cohen led the ♣7 and Berkowitz slipped in the 4. A surprised Harrington won the jack and, recognizing that he needed to ruff only one club instead of two, immediately played on trumps. Harrington made the standard play of the ace followed by a low spade to the jack, losing to the doubleton queen. Harrington still had to lose the ♦A, so he chalked up plus 450.

The way Harrington figures it, if Berkowitz had put in the ♣Q, it would have been necessary for Harrington to ruff two clubs in dummy, leaving him with a doubleton K-J before trumps were touched. In that case, he most likely would have played the ♠K first, followed by the jack, picking up the doubleton queen. Twelve tricks from that point, of course, would have been trivial.

But, nooooo. Berkowitz gave declarer his losing option, earning the perennial pairs contenders 20.5 matchpoints out of 38 instead of the 6.5 they would have had for minus 480.

Harrington recalls that when the deal was over, Berkowitz apologized to Cohen. "I guess I was asleep," Berkowitz said.

Said Cohen: "That was kind of a Rueful Rabbit play."

Whatever you call it, the play helped Berkowitz and Cohen to a 69% game.

Players bear responsibility for defenses to Mid-Chart methods

We have a short message for players who wish to play certain Mid-Chart methods: *there are no more yellow books*.

What does this mean? In case you don't know about the yellow book, it was the publication that contained the defenses to Mid-Chart methods such as the Multi 2♦. Players could pick up yellow books and carry them around for the benefit of their opponents.

Repeat: *there are no more yellow books*.

Instead, a player who wishes to use certain Mid-Chart methods must go to the ACBL web site on the Internet (www.acbl.org) and check the Mid-Chart section under "Conventions" to determine if the method is permitted. If it is, the player is obliged to print out the defense to the method and take it with him to the table.

Players who do not do this will not be permitted to play Mid-Chart methods that are covered by this regulation. Mid-Chart methods marked with an asterisk do not require written defenses.

At this tournament, there is a limited supply of printouts from the ACBL web site, but it is the responsibility of the players to determine whether their methods require these procedures and to take appropriate action when required.

1. Bruce Elliott, Percy Sheardown, Eric Murray and Sami Kehela, in 1964-65. Murray and Kehela were inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame on the opening night of this tournament.
2. No, not bridge. Not even hockey. It's lacrosse. The Iroquois were discovered playing the game by French explorers who thought the stick they used resembled a bishop's crozier – *la crosse*.
3. Douglas Drew was ACBL president in 1984 and held various other positions within the ACBL thereafter. He initiated action to create the ACBL Educational Foundation.
4. How about Canada's own gutsy Audrey Grant?
5. Victoria College, Toronto, in 1896 over Easter. Twenty-two teams from Ontario competed in a whist tournament. This continues to this day as the longest-running whist/bridge tournament in North America.
6. William Anderson. His charts helped Goren's point count system become wildly popular in the Forties and Fifties.
7. An appeal was made of a scoring error of 300 points by Canada many hours after the session they played against Germany. The appeal was denied. Germany went on to win the championship.
8. George Mittelman and Dianna Gordon won the Mixed Pairs in 1982.
9. Douglas Drury invented the convention that bears his name, with modern variations, including two-way reverse Drury. He served the ACBL as a member of the Board of Governors and on various committees.
10. Mark Molson, formerly of Montreal, won the Richmond Trophy – the Canadian version of the Barry Crane Top 500 – five years out of six and brought home the Bermuda Bowl silver medal to Canada in 1995.

\$10,000 in grants to Daily Bread

Charity foundations representing the Canadian Bridge Federation and the ACBL presented checks totaling \$10,000 (U.S.) to the Daily Bread Food Bank, which serves 140,000 people a year in metropolitan Toronto.

Ray Lee, president of the Canadian Bridge Federation, and Jayne Thomas, president of the ACBL Charity Foundation, presented a check for \$5,000 to Jim Martin of the food bank just before the opening session of the Life Master Pairs Saturday. Moments later, Lee and Marilyn White, charity chair of the Canadian Bridge Federation Charitable Foundation, presented a check for the same amount to Martin.

The mission of the Daily Bread Food Bank is to feed hungry people and to eliminate the need for food banks. Since 1983, this second-largest food bank in Canada has been providing food to people in need in the Greater Toronto Area. Fresh and non-perishable food from both the public and industry are collected

and centralized at the Daily Bread warehouse. From there it is sorted and distributed to 170 member agencies across the metropolitan area.

The member agencies host food programs that include neighborhood food banks, children's breakfast programs, hostels, hot meal programs, drop-in centers, and food-sharing projects. 140,000 people use emergency food programs every month in Toronto. Of those served by Daily Bread, 38% are children, 43% are disabled and about 10% are seniors.

In addition to providing food for member agencies and operating an on-site food program, Daily Bread provides other services, such as the advocacy and referral program. This program assists people in overcoming the circumstances that bring them to the food bank in the first place. This might include helping people with income or housing security or job searches.

Test their mettle

"If they don't cover, they don't have it," said Zia. Sometimes you have to give them the chance to cover – and Board 5 of the Educational Foundation Pairs Friday evening was a prime example.

Most of the East-West field bid to 4♠ by West. On the ♥10 opening lead East-West generally recorded plus 450 for an average minus.

Consider the spade suit. If the suit breaks 2-1, you can do what you like. If they are 3-0 offside, there's nothing you can do to avoid a loser. But 3-0 onside is a different matter. Win the ♥A and lead the ♠J – and test South's mettle! If he follows low, go up with the ace – and congratulate him afterwards. If he covers, you have the entries to repeat the spade finesse – and it will be up to him to congratulate you! There was half a top difference between plus 450 and plus 480.

Ralph Buchalter made a fine play on Board 4 to rake in a bushel of matchpoints.

Like virtually everyone else, he opened 1NT and bought it there on the ♥9 lead. He won and cleared spades, then won the third heart to cash the spades, South pitching the ♦8-7 perforce. Instead of setting up clubs by guessing the suit, he played the ♦K! South won and could cash a heart, but then had to lead a club before or after cashing the ♦Q. Buchalter had come down to the ♦9-5 and the ♣A-9 in dummy. All the defense could take was their ♦Q. Plus 120 was worth just about all the matchpoints for Buchalter.

Steve Robinson, with two possible entries, led his fourth best spade. Spangler played low from dummy, and Boyd produced – the 5! Spangler of course realized her only possible entry for the blocked clubs was the ♠Q. She could have won the trick with dummy's 6, of course, but that would have killed the dummy entry. So she took her only chance – she won the trick with her ace. She thought the ♠K was with South because of the opening lead and because of Boyd's play. So she cashed her clubs and led a spade, rising with the queen when Robinson played low. But now Boyd produced the king, and declarer was forever cut off from dummy. Boyd returned a heart, ducked to the king, but Spangler still had six tricks coming -- two hearts, two spades and two clubs. Setting 3NT three tricks was worth 24 of the 25 possible matchpoints.
